- 3. Attending an event? Tag us in a post on the event page on Facebook so people get to know about your charity.
- 4. You can bring your banner to any event free of charge.
- 5. Even on the day you get a discounted rate of £10. Bring 2 friends and you attend that event for free. Save the Eventbrite fees to by booking direct with your local coordinator.
- 6. Use your Promo slot at an event to tell the audience what you need help with. Our members are very generous.
- 7. Ask attendees in your to second promo slot to tweet about you or like your social media platforms.
- 8. Join the team and get paid to network. We will reduce the set up fee to just £50 and you get access to all of our marketing material, support online and in person and you when you make your events a success (with our support) you will get paid to network and have business owners coming to you every month. We work on a 50/50 split that's profit and work to make the events a success.
- 9. After each event we share photos of the event don't forget to visit our page and tag your charity in our event's pictures.
